This year the Ottumwa Symphony Orchestra is again sponsoring a Young Artist Competition for high school students.

## The competition will be held:

- Sunday afternoon, February 11, 2024
- First Presbyterian Church, 228 W. Fourth Street, Ottumwa, Iowa
- The competition is limited to high school aged students (grades 9-12) who live in Iowa.
- Previous winners who have performed on the concert are not eligible to compete on the same instrument in successive years.

## The winners:

- First Place will receive \$300
- If selected must agree to appear at the March 9th concert with the Ottumwa Symphony at the Bridge View Center in Ottumwa
- 2nd place cash prize is \$200
- 3<sup>rd</sup> place \$100
- Cash prizes will be awarded whether or not a contestant is selected to appear with the Symphony

#### Auditions:

- Each participant must be accompanied by piano. Each participant will have a 15 minute time slot
- It is the responsibility of the performer to confirm the existence and availability of an orchestral accompaniment for their selection prior to auditioning.
- Participants must provide the judges with a copy of the solo and piano accompaniment.

## Entry Deadline: Entries must be received by January 29, 2024.

## **Ottumwa Symphony Young Artists' Competition Rules**

## Eligibility

- For strings, woodwinds, brass, percussion, piano, voice, harp and guitar.
- Must be in high school (grades 9-12) and have not reached 19 years of age on the application deadline date.
- Contestants must be a resident of lowa.
- Previous winners who have performed with the orchestra are not eligible to compete on the same instrument in successive years.
- Contestants may audition in one medium (piano, voice, instrument)

## **Audition Requirements**

- All contestants are expected to perform either a movement of a concerto or a composition for solo instrument/voice and orchestra.
- Those auditioning are encouraged to perform from memory.
- instrument/voice and orchestra.
- The use of piano accompaniment is required for all contestants. Each applicant is expected to provide their own accompanist. Please abbreviate lengthy tutti passages in the accompaniment
- Compositions must be no longer than 15 minutes.
- One original score of each selection to be performed must be provided to the judges on the day of the competition. No photocopies are allowed.
- All contestants must attach an unedited audio file (mp3) recording of the contestant performing their audition piece. If more than 12 contestants enter, an audio preliminary round will be held using the recordings. Contestants will be notified on February 5 as to whether a preliminary round is being held.

NOTES: 1. Because of the difficulty and cost of obtaining some orchestra parts, acceptability of your selection is at the discretion of the Ottumwa Symphony. 2. Entrants must be available on Friday evening March 8 for rehearsal, and Saturday, March 9 for rehearsal and concert. Other rehearsals may be arranged. #### The Competition

- Will be held Sunday, February 11, 2024 at First Presbyterian Church, 228 W Fourth Street, Ottumwa, Iowa beginning at 2:00 PM. Check in will begin at 1:00pm
- Each contestant will receive their performance time by February 5, 2024. A panel of judges will select the winner.
- First Prize is \$300 and a performance on the winter concert of the Ottumwa Symphony Orchestra\*
- Second Prize is \$200 and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place is awarded \$100.

Note: Decisions of the Ottumwa Symphony Young Artist Competition committee are final and as a stipulation of participation, applicants agree to abide by those decisions.

\*Performance with the Orchestra will be at the discretion of the Conductor and the panel of judges.
